School Supplies for Incoming Kindergarten Students:

Please label the following items with your child's name:

- 2 3-prong folders (1 take-home, 1 writer's workshop)
- 1 Mead Primary Journal (half writing lines, half blank for drawing)
- Crayola 16 count (two rows) watercolor paint set
- 1 standard size backpack
- 1 children's scissors (no plastic blade)
- 2 boxes of Crayola crayons (24 count)
- 2 boxes of Crayola colored pencils (12 count)
- 2 boxes of Crayola markers (10 count)
- 1 complete (undies, socks, pants, shirt) back-up outfit
- Sneakers to wear everyday to school

Community supplies, will be shared do not label:

- 6-pack of Elmer's glue sticks
- 1 pack of Ticonderoga #2 pencils (30 count)
- 3 boxes of tissues
- 3 packs of baby wipes
- Pony Beads
- Pipe cleaners
- Small and Large craft sticks
