School Supplies for Incoming Kindergarten Students:

Please label the following items with your child's name:

- 2 3-prong folders (1 take-home, 1 writer's workshop)
- 1 standard size plastic pencil box.
- 1 Mead Primary Journal (half writing lines, half blank for drawing).
- 1 standard size backpack.
- 1 children's scissors (no plastic blade).
- 2 boxes of Crayola crayons (8 count).
- 1 box of Crayola colored pencils (12 count).
- 1 box of Crayola markers (10 count).

Community supplies, will be shared do not label:

- 4-pack of Elmer's glue sticks.
- 2 packs of Ticonderoga #2 pencils (30 count).
- 1 pack of black Dry-erase markers (any brand).
- 1 roll of paper towels.
- 1 box of Kleenex.
- 1 container of Clorox wipes.
- 3 packs of baby wipes.
- 1 hand sanitizer with pump.

Technology: 1 set of headphones in a gallon Ziploc bag labelled with your child's name written clearly on the bag. **No ear buds!**
